

### Day 1 - Wednesday, October 23: The Journey Begins

We board our flight from LAX and head to Israel.

### Day 2 - Thursday, October 24: Aloha! Welcome to Israel!

Arrive at the Tel-Aviv airport, we begin with heading to Nazareth and we visit Mt. Precipece, this evening, we have a mini worship event with Joshua Aaron.

### Day 3 - Friday, October 25: Explore The Galilee

After a great Israeli breakfast, we start our day by stepping aboard a boat for a calm cruise on the Sea of Galilee. We will enjoy a worship service on the boat. We continue to Ginosar to view an ancient fishing boat used at the time of Christ and see a video. We proceed to Magdala and view an ancient Synagogue. Next, we visit Capernaum, where we visit the home of the Apostle Peter. At St. Peter's Primacy, we have communion and enjoy some private time. We have lunch on the shores of the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a special feast of St. Peter's Fish at own expense (this lunch plan might change). A short bus ride takes us to the Mount of Beatitudes where we hear the words of Jesus on the mount where the greatest sermon ever was preached, we spend some time in prayer here. Our last stop today will be at the Jordan River.

### Day 4 - Saturday, October 26: Golan Gems

We start this morning heading north to the border with Lebanon, and we visit Banias, Caesarea Philippi, and Tel Dan. Then we travel to the Golan Heights. From here, we proceed to Mt. Bental.

### Day 5 - Sunday, October 27: Heading To Jerusalem

We begin this morning at Beit Shean, the largest archaeological Park in Israel with beautiful excavations from Roman and Byzantine periods. It was here that the men of Jabesh Gilead rescued the body of Saul. We continue South the Jordan Valley and begin our ascension to Jerusalem, we stand atop the Mt. Of Olives, taking in the breathtaking view of Mount Moriah (Gen 22:2) and the Dome of the Rock from atop the Mount of Olives (Luke 22:39-42) the place where Yeshua will return. Our final stop today will be at Shepherds Field & Bethlehem, where the Word became flesh and where Yeshua was born.

### Day 6 - Monday, October 28: Jerusalem, City of Our Great King

This morning begins at the City of David as our guide recounts the early city of Jerusalem when King David ruled; viewing the pool of Siloam and even travel through the Tunnel (the dry tunnel). We proceed to visit the Davidson Center and the Southern Steps. Next, we go visit the Jewish Quarter and Tge Cardo. From here, we visit the Temple Institute where preparations are being made for building the Third Jewish Temple.

### Day 7 - Tuesday, October 29: Jerusalem, Old City

We begin this morning at Gethsemane, we have a time for private prayer and reflection in the private garden area, then a simple quick walk around the "traditional" garden area. Next, we proceed to St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda. Our next stop will be at the Western Wall, the last retaining wall of the Second Jewish quarter, here we walk through the fascinating Rabinical Kotel Tunnels. This afternoon, we enjoy some time to shop in Old City and some may choose to visit Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

### Day 8 - Wednesday, October 30: Jerusalem, A Jewish Heart

This morning we begin our day with a life changing visit to Yad Vashem where we will remember those whose lives were lost during the holocaust. We proceed to the Israel Museum to see the white jar cover/black wall and where the Dead Sea Scrolls are stored; here, we also see an impressive model of Jerusalem during the Second Temple period. Then, we continue to visit the Menorah outside the Knesset, we continue to the Klal building to pray over Jerusalem at the prayer tower.

### Day 9 - Thursday, October 31: Dead Sea

Begin this day descending to the lowest place on earth, we enjoy an in depth study tour of the Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Afterwards, we continue to the mountain top fortress of Masada with a cable car ride to the top. Here, our guide will treat us to the history of the famous zealot stand. After floating on the Dead Sea, we proceed to Ein Gedi, "Spring of the Goat," an oasis on the western shore of the Dead Sea. Because of its warm climate and abundant supply of water, the site developed a reputation for its fragrant plants and date palm groves. This is where King David spared King Saul, and where God defeated the enemies of the Israelites by praise and worship led by King Jehoshaphat (1 Sam 23:29; 24 Song of Songs 1:14).

### Day 10 - Friday, November 1: Jerusalem, Jesus Won!

We enter the Old City in Jerusalem today from Zion Gate, we visit the Upper room, next, we stop at the Saint Peter on Galllicantu, we make our way now to the Garden Tomb, Golgotha and Gordon's Calvary where Jesus was crucified, buried and resurrected. A Communion service is available for our group as we overlook the Tomb and celebrate the Eternal Victory of our Messiah. Our final stop today will be at the Valley of Elah, where David defeated Goliath.

### Day 11 - Saturday, November 2: Mediterranean Shores & Shalom!

This morning, we begin driving up on the coastal shores of the Mediterranean and visit Mt. Carmel, we learn of the power of prayer at the same area where Elijah earnestly prayed to end a 3-year drought (1 Kings 18:42) and spend time at the Monastery if time permits. We continue to explore the ancient site of Mt. Megiddo. Next, we proceed to Caesarea. Visit the aqueduct and the Roman amphitheater where Paul stood trial. Cornelius, the first Gentile of the Church-age was saved and received the Holy Spirit as he met Peter here, from here, we make our way to Yafo, Jonah's Port and visit the house of Simon the tanner. Following a farewell meal, we are transferred to the Ben Gurion International airport in Tel-Aviv to board our flight and head home. During our flight home, we cherish our sweet memories and we begin making plans for our return trip!

### Day 12 - Sunday, November 3: Arrive Home
