1. Have a D.T.R Talk with God

At that time the followers came to Jesus and asked, “Who is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?” Jesus called a little child to him and stood the child before his followers. Then he said, “I tell you the truth, you must change and become like little children. Otherwise, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. The greatest person in the kingdom of heaven is the one who makes himself humble like this child (Matthew 18:1 – 5 NIV).

- Go from Slave to Child

2. Relinquish Slavery and Receive Sonship

And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, “Abba, Father.” Now you are no longer a slave but God’s own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir (Galatians 4:6 - 7 NLT).

Because you are a Son/Daughter of God, Our Father, Approach Him Differently by . . .

- Listening to your Daddy’s Voice
- Speaking to your Daddy
- Being Real with your Christian Brothers and Sisters

3. Don’t Act Like a Child Instead Become a Child

But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of God. They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God (John 1:12 – 13 NLT).
