### March 16-28, 2024

#### Day 1 - Saturday, March 16: Our Journey Begins

Meeting at Los Angeles LAX; we board our plane, which soon takes off and we continue on our journey to Israel.

#### Day 2 - Sunday, March 17: Welcome to Israel!

Arrive at the Tel-Aviv airport. Bruchim Habaim and welcome to the Land of the Bible! After boarding our air-conditioned bus, we are now transferred to our hotel, located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea.

Overnight: Hadera, Jacob Hotel

#### Day 3 - Monday, March 18: Heading up to the Galilee

We begin this morning at Caesarea. We will visit the Roman amphitheater where Paul stood trial. It was here that the Gentiles first received the Holy Spirit. We proceed to drive north and visit Mt. Carmel, where Elijah called down fire from heaven and defeated the false prophets of Baal. If time permits, we visit Megiddo, the site of Armageddon, we proceed to drive through the Jezreel Valley and make our way to Mt. Precipice at Nazareth. Our final stop today will be at Ein Harod, our coach now takes us to the Sea of Galilee, we'll stay three nights here as our base.

Overnight: Tiberias, Ron Beach Hotel

#### Day 4 - Tuesday, March 19: Explore the Galilee

Begin the day with a beautiful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, we proceed to view an ancient boat used at the time of Jesus. Our travels now take us to Mt. of Beatitudes, we walk downhill towards the site of where Jesus fed the multitudes. Next, we head to Capernaum to visit the home of Simon Peter and to learn of the life of Jesus. At Tabgha, we spend time where Jesus fed the multitudes by blessing the very little the young boy had to offer. We have an opportunity now to be baptised at the Jordan River. We drive around the complete Sea of Galilee and finish this day with a visit at Kursi and Sussita.

#### Day 5 - Wednesday, March 20: The Golan Gems

Our travels today take us up to the Syrian Border. We visit Um-el-Kanatir and visit an ancient synagogue. We proceed now to Tel-Dan, where we combine a nature walk beside the Upper Jordan with views of the ancient ruins, topped by the Israelite high place that supported a golden calf (1 Kings 12). Then a short drive to Banias (Caesarea Philippi), dedicated to Pan the Greek god of pastures, flocks and shepherds; here Peter made his great profession of faith and recognized the Jesus is more than a prophet, He is the Christ (Matthew 16). We continue now to Mt. Bental and ascend onto the Golan Plateau for a magnificent view of upper Israel. Overnight: Tiberias, Ron Beach Hotel

#### Day 6 - Thursday, March 21: Enter into Jordan

After crossing the border, we drive to Jerash to visit the incredible Roman city built over 2,000 years ago. We proceed to travel to the Biblical town of Medeba for a visit to a church built over the 6th century mosaic map of the Holy Land. We then drive on to Mt. Nebo to view the mountains of Israel as Moses did just before he died. We continue now south for dinner and overnight on the Dead Sea shores. Overnight: Dead Sea, Marriott Hotel



#### Day 7 - Friday, March 22: Petra

Leaving the Dead Sea, we travel on the Kings Highway, the path of Moses and the children of Israel on their way to Caanan. We drive toward Kerak via Wadi El Mujeb, the Grand Canyon of the Middle East. We continue on to Petra for a day of touring the Red Rock City, considered to be the eighth wonder of the world, a complete city carved in colored sandstone. We explore the Nabatean city of Petra, including the breathtaking Treasury, the Palace of Justice and other amazing and spectacular sites. After passing back through the Siq, the natural gorge, we return to our hotel on the Dead Sea. Overnight: Dead Sea, Marriott Hotel

#### Day 8 - Saturday, March 23: Head to Jerusalem

Following a relaxing morning, we will transfer across the border to Israel, ascend to Jerusalem and begin our tour at the Mt. of Olives, taking in the breathtaking view of Mount Moriah (Gen 22:2) and the Dome of the Rock from atop the Mount of Olives (Luke 22:39-42). The Mount of Olives is where Jesus will return and the Temple Mount is where the 3rd Temple will be rebuilt prior to His appearing. After enjoying the view of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives, we visit the Church of All Nations and pray in the Garden of Gethsemane with a grand view of the Eastern Gate and the Kidron Valley. Here, we read the Scriptures of Jesus' prayer and take time for personal reflection where we literally walk where Jesus walked. Overnight: Jerusalem, Dan Hotel

#### Day 9 - Sunday, March 24: Jerusalem, Old City

We start today visiting the Temple Mount, we then enjoy some time at the Western Wall, the last retaining wall of the Second Jewish Temple, we make our way now to Ir David (City of David), at the Gihon Spring, we learn of how David overtook the city from the Jebusites and how the original city of Jerusalem was established. Following a visit at the Pool of Siloam, we proceed to Jaffa Gate and explore the Christian Quarter of the Old City. We visit Bethesda and walk through the final stops of the Via Dolorosa, next, we visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We finish this day with a visit to Bethlehem, here, we visit Shepherds Field and the



#### Day 10 - Monday, March 25: Jewish Heart

We begin this day by paying respect to the victims of the Holocaust at Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Memorial, this is a place both of great sadness and an experience of the spirit of hope and triumph, for those who trust in Messiah. We then go to the Netanya distribution center and have a time of Holocaust Survivor testimonies. Next, we take in the coastline views on a Mediterranean boat ride. We end the day with a Royalty Banquet in Netanya. Overnight: Jerusalem, Dan Hotel

#### Day 11 - Tuesday, March 26: Dead Sea

We begin today visiting Masada - ruins of King Herod's mountaintop fortress and last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against the Romans in 73 C.E. (ascend by cable car). Here, we will see the oldest operating synagogue in the world. The view of the Roman camps can still be seen from atop Masada, as well as a spectacular view of Jordan and the Dead Sea. We proceed to have an extensive hike at Ein Gedi where David fled from Saul. Our soul thirsts for God, for the living God (Psalms 42:2). We end the day visiting Qumran, where the famous Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered by a little shepherd boy. Overnight: Jerusalem, Dan Hotel

#### Day 12 - Wednesday, March 27: Shalom!

We begin this morning we visit at Mt. Zion, we visit the room of the Last Supper (Mark 14:13, Matt. 26:17-29, Acts 1:13 and Acts 2, the Pentecost), also known as the site of the Upper Room, and the traditional site of the Tomb of King David. Next, we visit the house of Caiaphas. Our next stop will be at the Garden Tomb, we have Holy Communion and celebrate together the resurrection power of Jesus Christ. It is finished! We travel now the valley of Elah, where David defeated Goliath. Our final stop will be at Jaffa, Jonah's Port. Following a farewell meal, we head to the Ben Gurion International Airport to board our flight and return home.
