POINT 1. GRACE Redefines Our Values

What's one area of your life (time, talent, or treasure) where you sense God might be shifting you from "ownership" to "stewardship"?

— What is helping you trust that shift?

How have you seen your values change as you've grown in your understanding of God's grace?

— Is there a mindset or habit God is gently reshaping?

POINT 2. GRACE Transforms Our Giving

Think about the sponge illustration: do you currently feel more like a "dry sponge" or a "soaked sponge"?

— What do you think helps you "soak in grace"?

When have you experienced an unexpected moment of receiving generosity?

— How did it impact your heart and your understanding of grace?

POINT 3. GRACE Redirects Our Trust

Where do you most often feel the "scarcity mindset" show up in your life?

- Time? Energy? Finances? Emotional bandwidth?
- How might God be inviting you to trust Him in that area?

What helps you remember that "God is more than enough" when life feels uncertain or overwhelming?

— How does that truth free you to be open-handed with others?

If generosity is the overflow of being gripped by grace, what is one simple, grace-driven step you feel led to take this week? - Not pressured - just overflow.
