Give Thanks: How Gratitude Shifts our Witness

1. JESUS SHIFTS OUR GRIEF INTO GRACE.

¹³ “Jesus answered, “Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, ¹⁴ but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life,” (John 4:13-14).

2. WE SHARE AS A GRATEFUL RESPONSE TO GRACE.

²⁸ “Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, ²⁹ “Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?” ³⁰ They came out of the town and made their way toward Him,” (John 4:27-30).

2. What “well” do you naturally run to in search of comfort, meaning, or identity? What would it look like to let Jesus meet this deeper thirst instead?
